

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Do I need to read music?

A. Classes use both sheet music and lyrics. The basics of reading music will be covered in your beginner's handbook with hints and tips to help you to find your place and follow the music. Your tutor will help you every step of the way as will fellow members of the group. Please do not be afraid it's never as hard as you think. Q. Will I be expected to sing a solo in front of any one?

A. No, a solo may be offered to the group on a first come first serve basis. It is completely up to you whether you take a solo.

Q. Is there an age limit?

A. There is no upper age limit but members must be over 21+ to take part in the class.

Q. How many participants will be attending each class?

A. Class sizes vary. Evening mixed ability groups are generally between 15-40 people. Intermediate groups are capped at 12. Day time classes between 10-40.

Q. I've been told by friends and family that I can't sing should I come along anyway?

A. Yes, Love2sing provides a fun, relaxed & non-judgmental environment where you can explore your voice, gain confidence and learn how to best use the voice you already have. Q. Can I try a class before I join?

A. Free taster sessions are regularly available and are advertised via the website [home page](#). Classes and workshops may only be attended by students who have enrolled on the course in advance.

Q. Is there a session fee for each class or do I have to enrol for the full term?

A. All classes and workshops must be paid for in advance. **A session fee is not available. Payment is non-refundable.**

Q. Do classes & workshops fill up quickly?

A. Yes, book now to secure your place. Late enrolment is not always available.

Q. Are there crèche facilities available for children?

A. No unfortunately not.

Q. How fit do I need to be?

A. Love2sing classes are energetic and fun. However, if you need to sit and rest during a class this is absolutely fine and chairs are always supplied. Everyone can sing! You'll find your stamina for singing will quickly grow with each class you attend.

Q. What should I bring to the class?

A. WATER!!! It's simple but often forgotten. You may wish to buy a folder to house your music.

Q. How do I pay for my course or workshop?
